



Overview of State MAEP Laws Changed, Added, or Amended Since Enactment

§ 37-151-3. Repealed as of July 2002	SB 2649, 1997 amended and repealed sections of the original 1994 MAEP
§ 37-151-5. Definitions	Original 1994 definitions statute was changed in 1997, 2000, 2002, 2003, 2004, 2006, 2009, 2012, 2013, and 2017
§ 37-151-6. Funding requirement	This section was added in 2006, to be effective in 2007
§ 37-151-7. Determination of annual allocations	This is the basic computation section of the MAEP. The original 1994 law was changed in 1997, 2002, 2003, 2004, 2005, 2006, 2012, 2013, & 2014
§ 37-151-7.1. Annual report	Added in 2012
§ 37-151-8. Rules and regulations for use and accounting of at-risk funds	Added in 2008
§ 37-151-10. Center for Education Analysis	Added in 1998
§§ 37-151-15 to 37-151-23. Repealed by Laws 2011	Education Technology Enhancement Funds repealed in 2011; Specifically, it repealed the Education Technology Fund (which had already been amended in 2005 from the original 1994 bill)
§ 37-151-25. Tech-Prep Fund	Original 1994 law was changed or amended in 1995, 1997, and 2005
§§ 37-151-27 to 37-151-57. Repealed by Laws 2005	Former §§ 37-151-27 to 37-151-57 (1994) authorized the issuance of State Education Technology bonds for the State Public School Education Technology Fund and the Tech-Prep Fund.
§ 37-151-77. Pupil-teacher ratio	Funding qualifications: This 1997 addition to the original MAEP statute was amended in 2009. This is a component of funding that also has been modified and waived for school districts through administrative regulation, thus affecting the MAEP formula
§ 37-151-79. Allowance of state funds for vocational education programs	1997 addition to the original 1994 law
§ 37-151-81. Additions to allotments for teachers employed in exceptional and gifted children programs	1997 addition to the original 1994 law
§ 37-151-83. State funding of alternative school programs	1997 addition to the original 1994 law
§ 37-151-85. Calculating per-pupil transportation costs	Originally added with the 1997 revision, this law was amended or modified in 2004, 2005, and 2006; including removing the requirement that school districts not only have a plan for efficiency, but also removed any administrative penalties for not submitting plans for reviews by the MDE
§ 37-151-87. Reduction of local supplement or support from ad valorem taxation	Added in 1997, this statute was amended in 2010
§ 37-151-91. Salary schedules	While this section has not been modified since its addition in 1997, it references § 37-19-7, which is amended almost every year
§ 37-151-93. Education program allotments for districts receiving legally transferred students	1997 addition to the original 1994 law
§ 37-151-95. Employee health insurance costs	1997 addition to the original 1994 law
§ 37-151-97. Annual report	1997 addition to the original 1994 law, amended in 2011
§ 37-151-99. Preliminary estimate of amount each school board to receive	1997 addition to the original 1994 law
§ 37-151-101. Distribution of common school and adequate education program funds	1997 addition to the original 1994 law, amended in 2013
§ 37-151-103. Payment schedule; adjustment of allotments	1997 addition to the original 1994 law, became effective in 2002, then amended in 2003, 2012, 2013, and 2014
§ 37-151-105. Regulation for determining average daily attendance	1997 addition to the original 1994 law; which allowed the State Department of Education to regulate ADA, which they did not do until specifically required by the Legislature in 2013
§ 37-151-107. Penalties for violation of provisions of chapter	1997 addition to the original 1994 law; this references the MAEP overall, but most of the penalties that were throughout the chapter have been removed over time.
